- Don't be your own likes and dislikes. Be objective in your assessment.
- Keep constant communication with parents. Draw them in to the lives of their children.
- Learn to manage emotions, know the price of each word.
- Regularly evaluate the work, successes and failures.
- Do not stop there. Remember that hard work is the condition of any success in life, laziness is the cause of all ills and evils.
- Choosing teaching methods, do not forget about their diversity. Implement new methods of learning, mindful of the traditional.
- Explaining the material, use and combine different forms of work.
- Visit classes of colleagues. By studying their experience, search for your.
- Be consistent in your actions. Create your own system and teach to her students.
